My National History Day project is about two people, Harry and Bertha Holt, who changed many children's lives in the 1950's by giving them a family through international adoption. The Holts adopted eight Korean war orphans in 1955, even though they already had six biological children of their own. They also helped other families find children through international adoption. I chose this topic because I have a strong connection with it. My brother and I were both adopted through the Holt International Children's Services, and my adoptive mom and brother even got to meet Bertha Holt.

In my research, I used several secondary sources. My most useful sources were two online magazine articles that included information about Bertha Holt leading the international adoption movement. Then I found primary sources to get even more information about the Holt family. I interviewed one of the Holts' adopted children and two of their birth children. I found the document called the Holt Bill, which allowed the Holts to bring their eight adopted children from Korea to the U.S. I used that in my website. I also read Bertha's book, *The Seed from the East*, which explains the process of adopting the eight Holt children and what followed. In addition, I found several primary

source images, videos, and newspaper articles, which I used in building in my website.
